

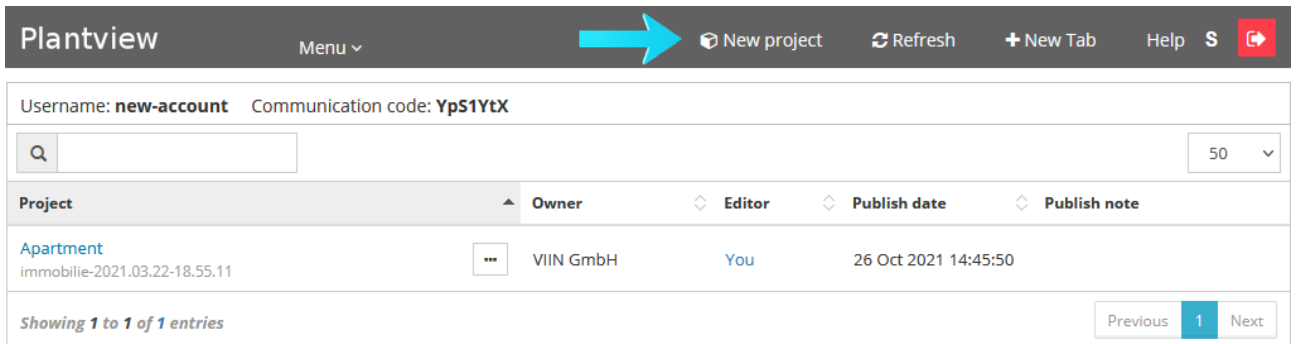
Create a new Project

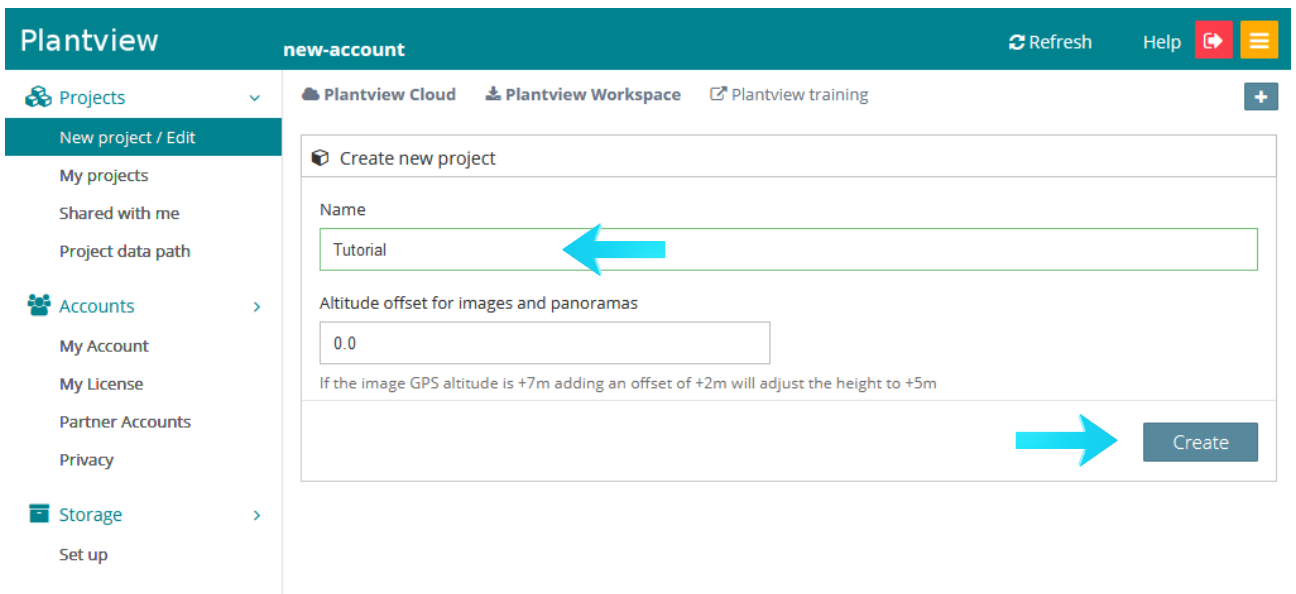

2.

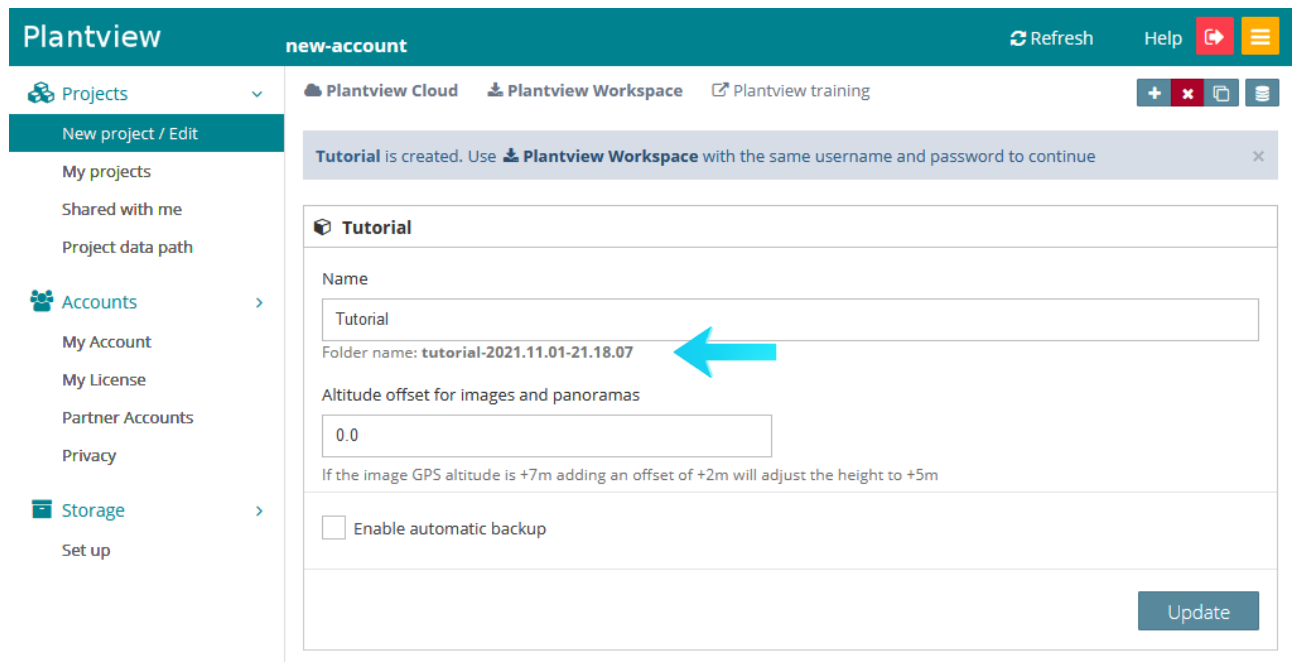
The Administration section will open in a new tab. Enter the project name and press **Create**.

The folder name is the unique name of the directory where the data will be located on your computer.




